'Like a child at play'

Aaron Pickens' exhibit, 'Toy Tableaux,' to be displayed on Saturday at Crary Art Gallery

Aaron Pickens creates his still lifes "like a child at play."

The imagery, the content, why he throws together what winds up in the still life at all, he said of his work, is less about agenda and more about the process in the imagery. "I don't go into it with a specific idea," he said.

He said that if he has an agenda with his work at all, its to "feel like I captured it. To do it justice." One of the ways that Pickens quantifies that element in his work is the way he's able to represent light. Having had an experience with a Rembrandt during his time in art school that changed his understanding of the ability of an artist to capture and to convey, in which the luminosity of the painting was the central figure, Pickens said he's always kept that moment at the forefront of his mind and striven to recreate what Rembrandt was able to achieve with it.

The majority of the work he'll be opening for exhibit at the Crary Gallery on March 12 — the exhibit titled Toy Tableaux — was created
